EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING

Those attending were President Mary Pierson, 1VP Noel Summral, 2VP Pat Sheehy, Treasurer Roy Stewart, Secretary Diane Moore, District One Representative Tucker Russell, District Two Representative Jewell C. Lockhart, District Three Representative James Chester Sawyer, District Four Representative Ellawese McLendon, Immediate Past President Ray Sheehy, Region III Field Vice President Robert S. Harrell, NARFE-PAC Chair Mazine Winstead, and Alzheimers Chairperson Jesse McDonald.

President Pierson said she plans to work closely with the District Representative's on Pre-Retirement Seminars. President Pierson asked for points of contact and phone numbers for all government agencies within each District Representative's area. NARFE will present a 20-30 minute briefing in the morning session just before the break at each and every seminar.

President Pierson said another goal over the next two years would be to establish additional NARFE chapters within the state and to retain those currently in operation. She reminded members it only takes five Federal employees to establish a chapter.
